OBITUARY HENRY BROCKMILLER, IRE- NE, SO. DAKOTA

Died on the Place of His
Birth—Nearly 40 Yrs.
Of Age

Henry Brockmiller was born Nov. 1st, 1886 in Yankton County, S. D. in the home where he has lived ever since. He died at the hospital in Yankton, May 27th, 1926, at the age of 39 years, 6 months and 26 days.

He will be severely missed in our little congregation. It is a great loss to us all that Henry has left us; but our loss has been
