FUNERAL SERVICES HELD HERE MONDAY FOR AAGE IBSEN

Services for Aage Ibsen were held at Our Savior's Lutheran Church on Monday afternoon, Feb. 22, 1965. Pastor Thorvald Hansen officiated and Mrs. Kermit Holm sang two numbers. Mrs. Oliver Anderson was at the organ. Pallbearers were: Ray Killion, Dr. Dean Clarke, Dr. William Rodda, Charles Olsen, Leland Paulsen and James Rasmussen.

Aage Ibsen, the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. P. Ibsen, was born at Viborg, South Dakota, on March 18, 1904. He was baptized and confirmed in Our Savior's Lutheran Church of which he was a member at the time of his death at Fairbault, Minn., on February 18, 1965.

On February 15, 1928, he was married to Lenora Paulsen. The first thirteen years of their married life were spent in farming near Yankton, South Dakota. In 1941 they moved back to the Viborg area where they operated a dairy farm and Ibsen's Dairy until the time of their retirement. In 1960 they moved to the town of Viborg.

Five children were born to Aage and Lenora Ibsen: Alice (Mrs. Dean Clarke) of Fairbault, Minn.; Dorothy (Mrs. William Rodda) of Charles City, Iowa; Irvin of Des Moines, Iowa; Bertha (Mrs. Ray Killion) of Omaha, Nebr.; and Rita who attends the University of Minnesota. In addition to these, six grandchildren also survive.

Mrs. Ibsen died in January of 1964.
