Funeral services for Petrea N. Larson were held on Monday, December 8, 1975, from the Viborg United Methodist Church with Pastors Roger Thomas and Jalmer Eldal officiating. Organist was Mrs. J. Merle Peterson, and soloist was Mrs. Curtis Rasmussen who sang "What A Friend We Have In Jesus" and "Beneath the Cross of Jesus". "Blessed Assurance" was sung by the congregation. Pallbearers were, Richard Larsen, Maynard Larsen, Murnell Larsen, Guy Skogen, Joe Larson and Donald Mark. Interment was in the Hurley Cemetery.

Petrea N. Larsen was born June 27, 1889, at Aalborg, Denmark. She came to America in December of 1911. On August 22, 1913, she was united in marriage to Paul Larson of Parker, S. D. They farmed in the Hurley and Viborg area, and had also resded in Viborg, until in 1960 they moved into the Bethesda Home at Beresford.

Paul passed away September 7, 1962, and Petrea continued to make her home at Bethesda. She passed away Friday, December 5, 1975.

She was preceded by her parents, four brothers and three sisters; her husband Paul; one daughter; and her son, Earl, on February 4, 1975. She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Albert Johnson (Rose) of Beresford, South Dakota; three grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Evie Larson of Sioux Falls, South Dakota; other relatives and friends.
