Funeral Services For Curtis D. Christensen Held Here On Monday

Funeral services for Curtis D. Christensen, who passed away on Tuesday evening, April 12th, at Beaumont, Texas, were held on Monday, April 18th. Services were held at his home at 1:30 P. M. and at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg with Rev. K. R. Jensen officiating. Pallbearers were James Madison, Gerald Morrison, Palmer Petersen, John Miller, Burdell and Burnell Christensen. Burial was at the Bethany Cemetery with full military honors. The Viborg Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Curtis Dale Christensen was born to Lars and Mae Christensen April 11, 1927, on a farm near Viborg. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He attended grade and high school in Viborg. After graduation he farmed with his father until he was inducted into the army. He served there for two years and was a Korean War veteran. He had made his home in Beaumont, Texas, for the past two years, and worked as parts man in the office of the Ideco Co. He was married on November 20th, 1953, to Leatha Small.

At the time of his death he was 28 years and 1 day old. Services were held for him last Friday at Beaumont, Texas.

He leaves to mourn him, his father, Lars Christensen, step-mother, Margaret Christensen, one sister and brother-in-law, Delores and Stanley Nielsen, one niece, two nephews, and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and a host of other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his mother in 1937.
