Karen Langeland, nee Johnson, was born July 26, 1857 in Blindstrup, Denmark. Together with her parents and two brothers, Christopher and Marinus, she left Denmark and came to Hurley, S. D., in 1885.

On April 20, 1889 she was married to Anders C. Langeland. To them were born 3 children, namely: Johnnie; Katherine, Mrs. Tarrel, of Salem, S. D.; and Peter. Mr. Langeland passed on in the year of 1907.

Mrs. Langeland was well and favorably known in this community where she has lived since she came to America. She has enjoyed good health and strength during her entire life until about two years ago when it was noticed that her health began to fail. Last Sunday morning, May 15th, she suffered a stroke from which she did not regain consciousness. The end came May 19, 1938, she being 80 years, 9 months and 23 days.

She leaves to mourn her death her son, Johnnie, who had always made his home with her; her daughter Katherine and her husband of Salem, S. D.; and Peter and his family. Seven grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren, one brother, Marinus Johnson, and family of Viborg. Other relatives and a host of friends and neighbors.
