LAST RITES HELD LAST MONDAY FOR MRS. A. N. HANSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Andrew N. Hansen, who died suddenly last Friday afternoon, were held on Monday afternoon at Bethany Lutheran Church, with Rev. John M. Jensen officiating. Mr. Ray Bak was the soloist and Mrs. Leonard Holm, organist. Pallbearers were Willie Sorensen, Leonard Sorensen, Omar Karp, Carl Lauridsen, Raymond Kaarup and LeRoy Christensen. Interment was at Rosehill cemetery, with the Viborg Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Minnie C. Hansen was born May 4, 1889, at the farm home west of Viborg, where she spent her childhood. She passed away suddenly at her home in Viborg, Friday afternoon, May 1, 1959 at the age of 69 years, 11 months, and 26 days. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, and was a member of the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg.

On April 30, 1914, she was united in marriage to Andrew N. Hansen. They were engaged in farming in Turner and Grant counties until 1926, when they moved to Viborg where they resided until her death.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Hans Henningsen, two brothers, Nels and Hans, and two sisters, Mrs. Martena Flint and Mrs. Etta Green.

She is survived by her husband, one sister, Mrs. Thorvald Nelson (Sena) of Irene, S. Dak., and one brother, Alfred Henningsen of Ventura, Calif., several neices and nephews, and a host of friends.
