Funeral services for Mrs. C. M. Andersen were held on Monday, May 8th, at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg with Rev. G. E. Udem officiating. Mrs. Glendow Bak was the soloist and Mrs. Leonard Holm, organist. Pallbearers were Burdell and Burnell Christensen, Norman Jensen, Lee Nelson, Kermit Nelson, and Duane Graber. Burial was in the Bethania Cemetery.

Marie Kamilla Ernstsen was born to Niels and Marie Ernstsen on January 29, 1890, in Ulballe, Fyn, Denmark. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

In 1912, she and her sister, Mrs. A. M. Nielsen, came to the United States and settled in Iowa. She was united in marriage to Chris M. Andersen on June 23, 1915. To this union five children were born, four of whom preceded her in death, three daughters in infancy, and a son, Glenn, who died in World War II. Her husband also preceded her in death in 1949.

She was a member of the Bethany Lutheran Church, and had lived in Viborg since 1932.

She passed away May 6, 1961, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital at the age of 71 years, 3 months, and 7 days.

She is survived by two sisters, Dagmar of Council Bluffs, Iowa, and Anna of Denmark; one son, Arlo, his wife, and three grandchildren, Kurt, Stephanie and Glenn. She was a kind and loving mother and grandmother with a great faith that will be missed by all.
