## JANET D. WHITTENBERG



Janet Dianne Whittenberg of Colleyville, Texas died 23 August 2010 in the Hospice House of Fort Worth from Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma.

Janet was born at home in Turner County, South Dakota, July 12, 1946, as the youngest of three children to Leonard and Esther Hanson. Janet grew up on the family farm and was very active in Nazarene Young People's Society now Nazarene Youth International, and represented her church and district at International Institute in Estes Park,
