She attended the Viborg schools and was graduated from the high school. She attended the Madison State Normal School at Madison, South Dakota, for two years and for the next several years taught school in Viborg and this vicinity.

On August 19, 1918, she was married to Bert H. Pinney at Des Moines, Iowa, and they made their home on a farm near Viborg. Two children were born to this marriage, Gerald Ferris and Shirley Mae. In 1929 the family moved to Yankton where they lived for seven years. Since 1936 they have lived in Viborg. For the past two and a half years Mrs. Pinney has been ill and she passed away at their home on April 15, 1941, at the age of 48 years. She leaves to mourn her passing her husband, Bert H.
