Mrs. Christina Andersen (nee Thompson) died at Dagmar, Montana, Friday, June 13th, 1924.

Christina Anderson was born near Viborg and grew up to young womanhood in this vicinity. She was born January 11th, 1876, daughter of Andrew and Marie Thompson, who have both preceeded her in death. She was married to Nels P. Andersen with whom she went to North Dakota in 1902. Later they moved to Dagmar, Montana, where they have made their home until she was called away. Mrs. Andersen was taken sick with the flu years back and this left her with weak lungs; finally tuberculosis developed and to this white plague of the human race she finally succumbed.

Mrs. Andersen leaves to mourn her early departure, her husband, Nels P. Andersen, and 5 children. Her sister Mrs. Jens Jensen and two of her brothers, William Thompson and Jens Thompson, went up to attend their sisters funeral, which took place Monday, June 16th, from the Lutheran church at Dagmar, Montana.
