## SERVICES HELD FOR TONY ANDERSON

Tony Anderson, former resident of rural Freeman, S. D., died Tuesday, Oct. 2, at the Good Samaritan Center in Lennox, S. D.

A son of Fred Anderson and Tina Andieson Anderson, he was born on a farm at Gann Valley, S. D., Aug. 24, 1900. As a boy he moved to the Freeman area. In July of 1929 he married Myrtle Anderson. The couple farmed south of Freeman until 1965, and continued to live at Freeman until moving to Parker in 1977. In June of 1979 he moved to the Good Samaritan Center at Lennox.

He was preceded into death by his parents; a sister, Louise; three brothers, Andrew, George, and Chris; his wife, Myrtle; and a daughter, Berniece.

He is survived by one sister, Anna (Mrs. Albert V. Hansen) of Sioux Falls, S. D.

Burial was at Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery of rural Viborg. Funeral services were conducted at the George Boom Funeral Home of Sioux Falls, on Friday, Oct. 5.
