OBITUARY

Died on Friday Sept. 27th, 1918 at the Sacret Heart Hospital in Yankton, Mrs. Jennie Nelson of Salem Township. Mrs. Nelson was born June 10, 1844 in Skjanyinge, Mononsoken, Sweden. Immigrated to America in 1868. Was married to Nels B. Nelson in 1875 at Moline, Ill. where they lived for over 30 years. They then moved to South Dakota settling in Turner County, Salem Township in the year 1889. They then moved back to Moline and then returned again to their farm in 1893. To this union was born 7 children, 4 of whom are still living, Alfred who is with Uncle Sam's forces in France, Peter, John and Ellen of this place. Mr. Nelson died in 1902. Funeral was held on Monday and the body was laid to rest in the Salem cemetery. Blest be her memory!
