OBITUARY

On last Monday evening Jan. 27th Mrs Annie C. Petersen passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. J P Christensen, in this city, of paralysis at the age of 67 years and six months.

Mrs. Petersen was born in Flensburg, Denmark. In 1868 she came to America and settled at Chicago. In 1872 she was married to Mads Petersen. To this union six children were born but only one, Mrs. J P Christensen lived to survive the mother. Together with her husband they came out to Dakota with the early settlers in 1874, returning to Chicago in 1880. In 1894 Mr Petersen died and in 1913 Mrs. Petersen came to Viborg. Besides her daughter, she leaves to mourn, three grandchildren, one great grand child, three sisters in the old country and two brothers, Wilhelm Petersen of this place and Fred Petersen of Kansas.

After a long and useful life she died as she had lived—honored, trusted and loved. She reared her own monument while she lived in the hearts of all who knew her. Her life was completed if work all done and well done constitutes completion. Her life was gentle but like the still waters it was deep.

The funeral services were held from the house and the M E Church on Thursday afternoon. Rev H Folkstad officiated. Burial was made in the Methodist cemetery.
