HANS CHRISTIAN HANSEN

Hans Christian Hansen, son of Hans and Maren Hansen, was born on December 20, 1872 in Fyn Denmark. He was baptized into the Lutheran faith in Denmark. At the age of seven he immigrated with his parents to the United States, where they homesteaded in Salem Township of Turner County, South Dakota.

On June 3, 1901, he was united in marriage to Margrethe Andersen. They settled in Spring Valley Township of Turner County and engaged in farming and lived there until he passed away. To this union were born six children: Mendi, Mrs. Emil Miller, Menno), Sylvia, (Mrs. Elmond Graber of Irene, Verda (Mrs. Theodore Lonning, Parker), Leonard and Melvin of Viborg. One infant daughter, his parents, two sisters and four brothers preceded him in death.

After a lingering illness, Mr. Hansen died at his home on January 24, 1946, having reached the age of 73 years, 1 month and 4 days. He leaves to mourn his passing, his beloved wife, two sons, three daughters, one daughter-in-law, three sons-in-law, 7 grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Louis Christensen and Mrs. Chester Hankins, and one brother, Larns Hansen.

Funeral services were held on Saturday, January 26, 1946 at the Spring Valley Lutheran Church, of which he has been a member for a great number of years, with Rev. Kenneth Petersen officiating. Pallbearers were six of Mr. Hansen's nephews.
