**OBITUARY OF MRS.
CHRISTINE JENSEN**

Mrs. Christine H. Jensen was born June 5th, 1857. At the age of 15 she came to America with her parents and settled at Toledo, Ohio.

After a short stay in Ohio the family felt the call of the Western country and soon found their way to the Dakota Territory where they took residence.

In 1878 Mrs. Jensen was united in marriage to Nels P. Jensen. The Jensen's remained in the near vicinity of Daneville except for five years from 1910 to 1915 when they resided in Sioux Falls, S. D.

The Jensen's served faithfully in the church which to them held 'an exalted place.'

At an early hour Sunday, February 27th, 1938, Mrs. Jensen quietly took leave of our troubled world. Her passing was peaceful, much as was her whole life.

She was preceded in death by an only son who died in 1908, and by Mr. Jensen who passed away September 23, 1928.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Anne Nelson, Tenork, N. D., and Mrs. Elsie Magrum, Oak Harbor, Ohio; six daughters — Mrs. L. P. Peterson, Irene, S. D., Mrs. Julius Johnson, Sioux City, Ia., Mrs. C. M. Jorgensen and Mrs. Steven Johnson, Viborg, S. D., Mrs. Charles Wernstrum, Lake Park, Ia., and Mrs. H. P. Hansen, Seattle Washington.

Funeral services were conducted by the Reverend W. Morris Kildal at the Methodist church. Interment followed at Rose Hill cemetery.
