FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FRIDAY FOR EVEN N. JENSEN

Funeral services were held on Friday, April 16th, for Even N. Jensen at the Spring Valley Lutheran Church, Rev. O. H. Brandt officiating. Burial was in the Church Cemetery.

Even N. Jensen, son of Petrea and Carl Jensen, was born on March 23, 1889, in Spring Valley Township, Turner County.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith at the Spring Valley Church.

On December 17, 1913, he was married to Rosie Larsen. To this union one daughter, Verna, was born.

He spent the first 33 years of his life on several farms in the surrounding community, and 22 years on a farm near Irene, S. D. Due to failing health he became a resident of Sunset Manor at Irene 5 years ago.

He became ill in February with flu and pneumonia and was admitted to Pioneer Memorial Hospital on Feb. 23rd. He returned to Sunset Manor and passed away there on April 13th at the age of 87 years and 21 days.

Mr. Jensen is survived by his daughter Verna (Mrs. Howard C. Petersen), three grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, one sister, Mrs. Charlie Andersen of Concord Home, Yankton, S. D.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, one sister, and seven brothers.
