FUNERAL SERVICES HELD FRIDAY FOR FRIDA RENNICH

Funeral services for Frida Rennich were held on Friday, December 14, 1979, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg with Pastor Charles Lindgren officiating. Organist was Mrs. Duane Larsen and special music was by Mrs. Charles Lindgren. A prayer service was held at the Fraternal Funeral Home on Thursday evening, Dec. 13.

Frida Rennich was born Dec. 15, 1912, at home located in the Center Point area. She was the daughter of Antonius and Dagmar Mikkelsen and was baptized in the Lutheran faith at home by Pastor Hans Jersild. She was confirmed at Spring Valley Lutheran Church by Pastor Fritz Anderson.

As a young woman she worked for Dan Danielsen's west of Viborg. On November 15, 1936, she was united in marriage to Henry Rennich at the Viborg parsonage by Pastor Harris Jespersen. They farmed in the Hurley-Centerville, and Viborg areas, retiring in 1973.
