LAST RITES HELD FOR MRS. M. JOHNSON

Funeral services for Mrs. Marvin Johnson were held Friday afternoon, Jan. 15, from the Bethany Lutheran Church. Rev. G. E. Undem officiated. Music was furnished by Mrs. Kenneth Knudsen, soloist, and Mrs. James Oakland, organist. Casketbearers were Louis Larson, Hilmer Lier, Henry Chase, Albert Dangel, Irvie Nelson and Luverne Swensen. Interment was at Bethania cemetery, Viborg.

Gladys M. Johnson, daughter of Nels and Emma Hansen, was born on a farm in the Center Point community, rural Viborg, S. Dak., Sept. 30, 1915.

She received her education in the country school and attended Viborg High School.

On Sept. 15, 1936, she was united in marriage to Marvin G. Johnson at Sioux Falls, S. Dak. To this union one son, Lowell, was born. They had farmed in the Viborg community all of their married life. Mr. Johnson passed away on Feb. 24, 1964.

She is survived by her son, Lowell, Viborg, S. Dak.; and by two brothers, Edwin R. Hansen, Sioux Falls, S. Dak., and Duane A. Hansen, Viborg, S. Dak.

Besides her husband she was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Luverne Hansen, who passed away in 1949.
