Inged Marie Andersen, nee Christensen, was born in Agersund, Jylland, Denmark, September 30, 1879. She passed away at her home in Salem township September 17, 1927, being at the time of her death 47 years, 11 months and 17 days of age.

She came to this country in 1900, and the same year she was united in marriage to Niels Nielsen, but about thirteen months after their marriage Mr. Nielsen died. To this union was born one daughter, Christine, now Mrs. Axel Christensen. In 1906 she married Jeppe Andersen, and to this union was born two daughters, Catherine and Verna. These three children together with their father are left to mourn the loss of a loving and faithful wife and mother. Of other relatives she leaves two grandchildren, and in Denmark she has three brothers and two sisters. Mrs. Andersen was a member of the Spring Valley Lutheran church, and also a member of the Ladies Aid society of the same church. She was also a member of "Søster Samfundet".

Funeral services were held in the home and in the Spring Valley Lutheran church September 19, 1927. The services were conducted by the pastor, Rev. Frits Andersen. That Mrs. Andersen was highly esteemed and had many friends was also shown by the large funeral procession and the beautiful floral offering. She was laid to rest in the Spring Valley Danish Ev. Lutheran cemetery.
