Mrs. Esther Aalborg Axelson, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Charley Aalborg, was born August 15, 1893, at Viborg, S. Dak., and passed to her rest on November 13, 1951, at Grand Junction, Colo.

In 1915, Mrs. Axelson graduated as a nurse from the Nebraska Sanitarium School of Nursing, which profession she followed until her marriage.

She was united in marriage to Lawrence Axelson on February 25, 1926, at Viborg, S. Dak., after which they made their home in Exira, Ia. Twenty-two years ago they moved to Colorado and settled on a peach farm in Palisade.

At the early age of 10 years, she was baptized into the Advent faith and remained a faithful and active member until her death.

Through her activity and interest, two displaced persons, Mr. and Mrs. Alex Shaden, were brought from Europe and for awhile given shelter in her home until they were able to maintain themselves.

On September 7th, she was suddenly stricken with an abdominal distress. She was rushed to the hospital and everything was done for her that kind hands and human medical skill could do. After several weeks of anxious waiting, her condition improved and gave promise for her recovery in-so-much that she was released from the hospital and taken home. Nevertheless, He who knows the end from the beginning, and He who has supreme interest in those who love Him, has declared her work finished.
