MORTON ANDERSEN PASSED AWAY LAST WEDNESDAY

Born in Arenstminde Jylland Denmark Dec. 6, 1855

HOMESTEADED IN
SALEM TOWNSHIP

Wife and Seven Children
Mourn Death—Funrel
Saturday

Last Saturday occurred the funeral of Morten Andersen who passed away Wednesday of last week at his home here in Viborg. His death was caused by a severe sickness of both heart trouble and pneumonia.

Morten Andersen was born in Arenstminde Jylland, Denmark, Dec. 6, 1855. He spent his boyhood and young manhood days in Denmark. In the year 1884 he together with his family came to America and settled down in this community out in Salem twp. where he took a homestead. In his wedded life there were born nine children of which two are dead.

Thirteen years ago he retired from the farm and moved to Viborg. And it was while here that he took sick and died the sixth day of April.

He leaves to mourn his death a wife who is in Denmark, seven children who are Mrs. Chris Hansen, Viborg, S. D.; Elmer Andersen, Hurley, S. D.; Andrew Andersen, Viborg, S. D.; Chris Andersen, Menno, S. D.; Mrs. Axel Pearson, Annie Andersen, and Clifford Andersen all of Viborg, S. D.; thirteen grandchildren, and one great grandchild. Besides his children there are also two brothers here in America, Lars Andersen, Platte, S. D. and Nels Peter Andersen, Hurley, S. D. and a brother and sister in Denmark.

Funeral services were held last Saturday afternoon at one o'clock at the home and later out in the Spring Valley Baptist church in which cemetery interment was made. Rev. Hans Jersild officiated and a quartet from the Bethania Lutheran church furnished music.
