## LAST RITES HELD FOR MARTIN PETERSEN

Funeral services for Martin Petersen, 69, who passed away suddenly Tuesday, Nov. 25th, were held on Friday, Nov. 28th, at the Viborg Funeral Home, Rev. Gordon C. McMillan officiating. Mrs. Donald Mark was soloist with Mrs. Gordon McMillan at the piano. Pallbearers were Donald Mark, Robert Mark, Curtis Mark, Ellwood Paulsen, Donald Jensen and Walter Knudsen, Jr. Burial was at Rosehill Cemetery, Viborg, with the Gaddis Funeral Home in charge. Lunch following the funeral was served by the family.

The death of Martin Petersen came rather suddenly on Tuesday, Nov. 25th, after a long illness. He was born in Denmark in 1888 and was 69 years old. He would have had his 70th birthday on December 6th.

He came to this country in 1911 and farmed to the south of Viborg until 1938 when he and his wife moved to Viborg.

He married Mabel Mork on June 2nd of 1920 and to this union was born one son, Albert Gould Petersen, now of Wichita, Kansas.

Martin Petersen served in World War I in Germany and was a member of the Viborg D. B. S. and the Odd Fellows organization.

He was baptized and confirmed by the Lutheran Church while yet a boy in Denmark.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his family and relatives and a host of friends.
