Services Held For Johie Eide, 58

Johie Eide, 58, rural Irene, died July 16, 1988, at the Royal C. Johnson Veteran Memorial Hospital.

He was born December 25, 1929, to Arnt and Marie (Lee) Eide. He was baptized and confirmed in Meldahl Lutheran Church. He attended the rural Sletton school.

He served in the U.S. Army in Korea and was awarded two combat medal stars. After his discharge, he farmed the home place until his health failed.

evening. Organist was Mrs. Keith Jensen and soloist was Johie's niece, Julie Villadsen.
