FUNERAL SERVICES HELD MONDAY FOR ANTON JACOBSON

Funeral services were held from the Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg for Anton Jacobsen on Monday, Sept. 9, 1974. Pastor Virgil White officiated. Organist was Mrs. James Oakland, and soloist was Roger Anderson. Pallbearers were: Arlo Andersen, James Andal, Raymond Jespersen, Kermit Holm, Floyd Wylie and Elwood Paulsen. Interment was in Bethania Cemetery with the Viborg Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Anton Jacobsen was born to Jens and Nielsine Jakobsen on May 23, 1895, in Aarhus, Denmark. He was baptized into the Lutheran faith on Oct. 20, 1895. Anton immigrated to the United States at the age of 17 and became a naturalized citizen on Jan. 22, 1919.

He was united in marriage to Jessie Petersen on Oct. 25, 1922, at Bethany Lutheran Church of Viborg.

He farmed in the Viborg community for approximately 50 years and retired in 1968. He was an active member of the following organizations: Farmers Lumber Company, Viborg Co-op Elevator, Danish Brotherhood Society, Swan Lake Township Board, Swan Lake District School Board, Lutheran Cemetery Association, and member of the Church Council of Bethany Lutheran Church.

Anton Jacobsen passed away on Friday, Sept. 6, 1974, at Pioneer Memorial Hospital after attaining the age of 79 years, 3 months and 14 days.

Survivors include the widow; one son, Robert of Viborg; three daughters: Mrs. Gladys Christensen of Trimont, Minn., Mrs. Doris Helgager of Aberdeen, S. Dak., and Mrs. Alyce Hammerstrom of Canton, S. D.; thirteen grandchildren; and two sisters: Jacobine Laursen of Aarhus, Denmark, and Kathrene Borreson of Sorring, Denmark.
