JENS EDWARD CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Jens Edward Christensen were held on Friday afternoon at 1:00 P. M. at the Dindot Funeral Home in Lennox, and at 2:00 P. M. at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg, with Rev. Harald Ibsen officiating. Pallbearers were Jake Vietor, Peter Vietor, Joe Sigle, Dick Berens, Herman Berens and Herman Plucker. Interment was at Bethany Cemetery west of town.

Jens Edward Christensen, son of Hanna and Villads Christensen, was born in Vraa, Vensyssel, Denmark, on June 10th, 1883, and there he spent the early years of his life. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in Denmark. In the spring of 1907 he immigrated to the U. S. A. and came to the Viborg vicinity to work.

On December 26, 1917, he was united in marriage to Anne Petersen. To this union five children were born. They farmed in the Viborg and Hurley vicinity until 9 years ago when they moved to a farm near Chancellor where he passed away suddenly on Feb. 2nd, 1954, at the age of 70 years and 7 months. He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his wife, Anne, and five children, Virgil of Centerville, Gwendolyn (Mrs. Ellsworth Danielsen), Viborg, Fern of Sioux Falls, Arlene (Mrs. Virgil Plucker) of Chancellor, and Darrell at home; also 6 grandchildren, 2 sisters, Mrs. Martin Christopherson of Hurley and Mrs. Jens Thomsen of Denmark, 4 brothers, Walther of Viborg, Martin of Irene, Chris and Anton in Denmark.

Everyone who knew him will always remember him as being kind, thoughtful and considerate in every way. He did not have an unpleasant word for anyone and never complained if bad luck came his way. He was willing to carry more than his share of the burden. A good and loving father, he will be greatly missed.
