A sad gloom was cast over our little city last Saturday, when it became known that death had entered the home of C. P. Frederickson and called Mrs. Frederickson to her reward.

Sarah Adelle Frederickson was born in the state of Ohio, October 7, 1865. when six years of age she came with her parents to Dakota Territory, locating at Childstown, (this name the township received from Mrs. Frederickson's father.) Mrs. Frederickson was converted and baptised when 16 years old; yes she consecrated her life to Him who came to give His life that she should have life everlasting. She remained faithful in in her believe in Christ and died in hope to receive a better home. She gave 10 years of her best life as a co-worker with her husband in actual mission work and no one knows what she has accomplished except those with whom she came in contact.

Mrs. Frederickson has been sick for the past three years, but in that time she has tried to regain her health by visiting Colorado, Arizona and New Mexico. She finally came to her home at Viborg last May and has since that time gradually failed. Still she has been able to be up every day until the last week when she had to remain in bed. The final summons came on the 24th day of December at 1 o'clock a. m. when God called to her to come up higher.

She entered into marriage with C. P. Frederickson June 2nd, 1891, and in that time God has blessed them with three fine boys who are now left behind with their father and many friends to mourn the loss of a good mother and kind wife.

The funeral services were held at the home last Sunday afternoon at 1 o'clock. A long procession followed the remains to the Baptist church where Rev. Bolvig preached an touching funeral sermon, after which the remains were laid to rest in the Baptist cemetery.
