Orman Nelson Services Held At Sturgis Saturday

Funeral services for Orman (Rip) Nelson were held Saturday at Sturgis, S. Dak., from the Anderson-Stingley Funeral Chapel with burial in Bear Butte cemetery. Mr. Nelson died at his home in Sturgis on Wednesday.

Orman Nelson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ole Nelson, was born April 11, 1908, at Viborg. He received his education here and following graduation moved to a ranch near Sundance, Wyo. Employed for the Homestake Mining Co. at Moskee from 1935 to 1941, Nelson later worked for six years at Custer State Park. For the past five years he was employed by the Sturgis Livestock Exchange.
