FUNERAL SERVICES HELD THURSDAY FOR EVERETT W. NELSON

Funeral services for Everett W. Nelson, 75, were held Thursday, July 26, from the First Baptist Church in Viborg, S. D. Pastor Pierre Tangent and Pastor Gordon McMillan officiated. Pastor McMillan sang "How Great Thou Art". Mrs. Gordon McMillan was organist. Pallbearers were, John and James Buckstead, Robert and Rolland Nelson, Charles and Royal Glood. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Everett W. Nelson was born June 12, 1898, in Viborg, South Dakota. He was the son of George and Cora Nelson. He attended Viborg schools and graduated from Viborg High School in 1917. He attended South Dakota State College for three months and was a member of the South Dakota State College in student Army Training Corps during World War I. He was a member of the American Legion for over 50 years, a 50-year member of Emounah Lodge No. 184, a member of the Yankton Consistory, and of the El Riad Shrine.

Everett was in the Security National Bank of Viborg for 50 years. He passed away July 22, 1973, at a hospital in Kansas City, Missouri.

He was married to Lois M. Peters on March 12, 1928. Lois preceded him in death in October of 1972. He was also preceded by his parents, and two brothers, Merton and Emmett.
