### RICHARD E. HEIM

Richard Ellsworth Heim was born at Viborg, S. Dak., March 21, 1927, and was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He was a member of the Bethany Lutheran Church. He attended school at Dist. No. 44 and in Viborg.

He entered the U. S. Army on July 3rd, 1945, at Ft. Snelling, Minn., and served in Switzerland, Austria and Germany. He received his honorable discharge from the army on January 3rd, 1947, at Ft. Sheridan, Ill. He had recently been employed at Port Angeles, Wash. Death came suddenly on October 28th, 1949.

He leaves to mourn besides his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Martin Heim, four brothers, Marvin of Spearfish, Lester of Sacramento, Calif., Clifford and Floyd of Viborg, and two sisters, Mrs. Stanley W. Bradley (Ruby) of River Edge, N. J., and Mrs. Clayton Buntin (Myrtle) of Reno, Nevada.
