FUNERAL SERVICES HELD SATURDAY FOR GEO. MELLEGAARD

Funeral services for George Mellegaard were held in the First Baptist Church of Viborg on Saturday, August 27, with Rev. K. L. Peterson officiating. Mrs. K. L. Peterson was the soloist and Mrs. Everett Nelson, the organist. Pallbearers were all nephews: Gary Jorgensen, James Mellegaard, Roy Mellegaard, Leslie Mellegaard, Verlyn Mellegaard, and Berchel Anderson. Burial was in the Hurley Cemetery.

George Obed Mellegaard, son of Knud P. Mellegaard and Elise Fawrup Mellegaard, was born Feb. 25, 1885, on the family homestead in Spring Valley Township. He passed away at the Freeman Hospital on August 24, 1966, at the age of 81 years, 6 months and 19 days.

Most of his life was spent in the Spring Valley and Viborg areas except for two years spent in Clay County farming. Four years ago he moved to a home in Viborg where he was living when he was taken to the hospital 8 weeks ago.

He was a life long member of the Odd Fellows Lodge in Viborg.

Surviving are four brothers: Fawrup and Romey of Hurley, John of Viborg, and Orris of Irene, and a host of neices and nephews.

Preceding him in death besides his parents were two brothers, Charlie and Alfred; and four sisters, Mrs. Nora Whiting, Mrs. Esther Anderson, Mrs. Hulda Overgaard, and Mrs. Anna Jorgensen.
