Last Rites Held For Vandal V. Madison

Funeral services for Vandal V. Madison, 41, were held Friday afternoon, Jan. 13, starting at two o'clock at Trinity Lutheran Church in Yankton. Burial was in the Yankton cemetery.

Mr. Madison, a former Viborg man, died Monday evening, Jan. 9, the victim of a heart attack. He had been taken to Sacred Heart hospital in an ambulance Monday afternoon. Mr. Madison had been troubled with a heart ailment a few years ago, but had been in apparent good health the past several years.

The Madisons farmed three miles east of Yankton for a number of years. He was born on a farm southeast of Viborg on September 11, 1914.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy, and one daughter Joan, Mrs. Luther Nelson of rural Yankton, his mother, Mrs. Amanda Lauridsen of Viborg, and three brothers, James B. Madison, Yankton, Eugene Madison, Sioux Falls, and Bill Madison, Mitchell. His father, Ernest Madison, and brother, Duane, preceded him in death.
