Leslie Flyger was born on November 7, 1912 at Hurley, SD to Chris and Mary (Larsen) Flyger. He grew up at Hurley and graduated from Hurley High School in 1930. On June 18, 1932 he was united in marriage to Naomi Peterson of Viborg at Vermillion, SD. Leslie farmed with his father for 3 years, then purchased a home and grocery business in Hurley. They operated the grocery store for several years. In 1954 they moved to a farm east of Hurley where he was engaged in farming until his retirement.
