MRS. MILLER CHRISTENSEN

Sena Mary Nelson, daughter of P. M. Nelson, deceased, was born in Chicago, Illinois, September 15, 1873. In the spring of 1874 she came with her parents to Daneville, South Dakota, where she grew to womanhood.

In January 1890 she was converted and baptized by Rev. Jacob Olsen into the Daneville Baptist church, which is now the First Baptist church of Viborg, of which church she was a consistent member unto the end. She was also a charter member of the What-I-Can Society and always faithful in its activities.

On the 21st day of December, 1898 Miss Nelson was united in marriage to Miller Christensen also of Viborg and moved on the farm north of Viborg.

In the year 1910 Mr. and Mrs. Christensen moved to Viborg and engaged in the jewelry business.

Besides her husband, she leaves three sisters and two brothers: Mrs. Lawrence Petersen, of Viborg; Mrs. Ora Karp, of Viborg; Mrs. P. B. Hansen of Sioux Falls, and Fred and P. H. Nelson, both of Viborg. Her parents, one brother and two sisters have preceded her in death.

Mrs. Christensen had been in poor health since June 1st, culminating in a surgical operation on Tuesday, August 20. She passed away August 28 at 2:30 p. m. at the McKennon hospital, Sioux Falls at the age of 55 years, 11 months and 13 days.

She was a quiet, unassuming woman, always faithful and ready to help wherever needed. She will not only be missed by her husband and relatives, but also by the church and by all who knew her.
