FUNERAL SERVICES HELD TUESDAY FOR NIELS C. NIELSEN

Funeral services for Niels C. Nielsen were held from the Spring Valley Lutheran Church on Tuesday, January 14th, 1975, with Pastor O. H. Brandt officiating. In 1933 they moved to the Mads J. Hansen farm, which they purchased. They moved into Viborg in 1954.
