Carl Martin Christopherson was the youngest of three sons born to Paul and Andrea Christopherson on January 21, 1888 near the small town of Kvissel in Denmark. He departed from this life August 10, 1984 at the age of 96 years, 6 months at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital, Viborg,

South Dakota.

He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith in his native land. In 1905 he immigrated to America and came to the Viborg-Centerville area. On February 9, 1915 he was united in marriage to Anne Christensen at Viborg. To this union four children were born. They farmed in the Hurley-Viborg area over fifty years. They retired and moved to Viborg in the fall of 1964. They
