Inga Osthus Andal, who passed away March 5th, was born October 11, 1898 in Rennesy, near Stavanger, Norway.

She was 31 years, 4 months and 25 days old when she died.

When fifteen years of age, she immigrated to U. S. on the 21st of July, 1914. She was united in marriage to Alfred Andal, October 8th, 1919.

They have made their home on the farm one mile west of Hooker. To this union was born five children. Those left to mourn are her husband, Alfred Andal and children Sylvia, James, VerDell, a little baby, and one boy who has gone Home before her. She leaves an aged mother, two brothers and three sisters in Norway and five brothers here, one brother in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma and a sister, Mrs. Magnus Kleven, of Minneapolis, Minn.

The funeral was held Saturday afternoon, March 8th from Bethlehem Lutheran church of Hooker. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. H. M. Solem, of Lennox. Burial followed at Holland cemetery. Mrs. C. E. Wheeler and Florence Frederickson sang solos at the services.
