Deaths

Jorgine Amelia Sorensen was born on April 10, 1862 at Jerup Elling; Sogn; Fredrickshavn; Denmark. At the age of 14 she emigrated to America, arriving at Neenah; Wiscon. July 3, 1886 she was united in the 2nd day of July; 1883. Two years later she was baptized and received into the fellowship of the Baptist church of that place. On July 3rd, 1886 she was united in Holy wedlock with Mr. Adolph C. Jensen unto which union six children were born. Two of them have passed on before. In 1894 Mrs. Jensen came with her husband to South Dakota where they settled on a farm in Turner County. Here they remained 21 years, and in the spring of 1915 moved into Viborg, where they lived until the death of Mr. Jensen on May 25th, 1927. Since the death of her husband Mrs. Jensen has made her home with her children. Being at the home of her son Calmor when the last summons came on December 3, 1928 at the age of 66 years 7 months and 23 days. She has been a faithful member of the 1st Baptist church of Viborg since coming to South Dakota. Two of the children have gone on before; Marion dying in infancy and Harvey who died 5 years ago. Those left to mourn the loss of their mother are: Arthur, of Kirkman Iowa; Walter and Calmor, both of Viborg; and Mrs. Wm. Zimmell of Sioux Falls, South Dakota.
