OBITUARY OF MRS. EINAR HANSEN

Carol Evelyn Hansen, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Amos Andersen, of Parker, was born at Parker on August 12, 1913. Here she lived her childhood and youth. She was educated in the city schools of Parker, both grade and high school. She graduated from the Parker high school with the class of 1931.

She was united in marriage to Einar Hansen of Viborg on August 20, 1931. After her marriage she, together with her husband and children, made her home on a farm near Viborg. To their marriage were born three children.

The illness that brought about her early death began about two years ago, the serious nature of which was learned about a year ago. She passed away at her home three and one-half miles northwest from Viborg on January 19, 1939, the cause being cancer, at the age of 25 years, 5 months and 7 days.

On December 1, 1938, according to her own desire, she received Christian baptism at her home.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the Bethany Lutheran church, the Rev. Einer Romer officiating. Burial was at the family lot at the Rose Hill cemetery of Parker.

She was preceded in death by a brother in the year of 1925.

She leaves to mourn her death, her husband and three children: Peggy Jean, 6, Johnny Lee, 5, and Shirley Ann, 3; her parents, Mr and Mrs. Amos Anderson, of Parker; three sisters, Mrs. Everett Engelkes, of Parker, Mrs. Elmer Harms of Sioux Falls, and Vera Andersen of Viborg; three brothers, Judy Andersen of Parker Louie Andersen of Sturgis, S. D., and Fred Andersen, of Lead, S. D.; as well as many neighbors and friends. All the relatives had come for the funeral.

The pall bearers were Peter Christensen, Chris Jorenson, Anton Jacobsen, Andrew Larsen, Martin Heima nd Ernest Christensen.
