Lars Christian Jepsen was born in Dronninglund Sogn, Denmark, February 24, 1878, and died at his home near Center Point, S. D., July 14, 1926, at the age of 48 years, 4 months and 20 days.

Mr. Jepsen was united in marriage to Miss Johanna Marie Jespersen on November 4, 1898. To this union ten children were born, one of whom passed away about 12 years ago.

Mr. Jepsen and family came to this country in September, 1904. He first farmed several places in the neighborhood of Viborg and Irene. Seven years ago he bought a farm near Center Point, their present home. Jepsen was a good farmer and a hard worker. He was a good and loving husband, father and neighbor. His wife and nine children, namely: Christian, Mrs. Harry Long, Mrs. Lloyd Sandell, Mrs. Willie Jensen, Alma, Clara, Violet, Clarence and Sylvia, are left to mourn the loss of a loving husband and father. He also leaves behind four grandchildren, his old father and four sisters and two brothers in Denmark, and one brother, Marinus, Parker, S. D. Mr. Jepsen was a member of the Turkey Valley Danish Lutheran church.

Funeral services were held in the home and Turkey Valley Lutheran church July 17, 1926. Rev. Frits Andersen preached the funeral ser-
