M. J. CHRISTENSEN WAS LAID TO REST LAST SATURDAY

End Comes Suddenly—Was
Resident Here Nearly
40 Years

Funeral Services for Martin Johan Christensen were held from the Spring Valley Danish Evangelical Lutheran church January 14th and interment made in the Spring Valley cemetery, thus bringing to a close the career of one who has been a resident of Viborg for 39 years.

Services were also held in the home, the Rev Frits Anderson preaching at both places. Death came suddenly from a stroke of paralysis, after the deceased who had been ill for three years was apparently getting somewhat better. A large funeral procession and many floral offerings marked the rites.

Martin J. Christensen as born in Sulsted, Aalborg Amt, Demark, Mar. 6th 1866 and was therefore nearly 62 years old. He came to this country in 1888. In 1890, he was married to Marie Thomsen and to this union three children were born, two of whom have passed on only one Alfred P. Christensen living.

In the year 1900, following the death in 1894 of his wife, Mr. Christensen made a trip to Denmark and a year later was married to Johanne Rasmussen and in the spring of that same year they came to America and made their home in Turner County. To this union three children were born only one, Leonard Christensen Valdemar surviving. An adopted daughter Fern now Mrs. Axel Christensen also survives. These three with Mrs. Christensen remain to mourn his loss.

He was well known here and his passing marks a distinct loss.
