Funeral Services Held For Mrs. Johanna Peck

Funeral services for Mrs. Johanna Peck were held on Saturday, Jan. 13th, from the Methodist Church in Viborg with Rev. Edgar Farnsworth officiating. Organist was Mrs. J. Merle Peterson and soloists were Mrs. Dean Ramsley and Mrs. Curtis Rasmussen. Pallbearers were Charles Drake, Henry Cramer, Wesley Arends, Jake Boomgarden, Wendell Arends, and Marvin Andernacht. Burial was in Bethania Cemetery.

Mrs. Johanna Peck (nee Arends) was born February 26, 1885, on a farm southwest of Chancellor, Dakota Territory. She was married to David E. Peck on March 24, 1910, in Zell, South Dakota. They lived in the Davis and Viborg communities most of their married years.

To this union four children were born, two sons and two daughters. She was preceded in death by her husband; one son, Henry, age 5; her parents; and three brothers and four sisters.

She leaves: one son, George of California; two daughters, Catherine Brown of Colorado and Johanna Christensen of California; four grandsons; one brother, Ben Arends of Willow Lake, S. Dak., and one sister, Winnie Drake of Chancellor, S. Dak.

Mrs. Peck passed away at the Morningside Manor at Alcester, S. Dak., on Wednesday, Jan. 10, 1968, at the age of 82 years, 10 months and 14 days.
