Bendina M. Nelson was born April 25, 1883, at Daneville, South Dakota, and grew to womanhood in this community. On February 20, 1901 she was united in marriage to Ole C. Nelson who preceded her in death by six

years, passing away on October 6, 1925, after having suffered as an invalid for thirteen years, during which trying time he was cared for by his wife, in the most self-sacrificing and devoted manner.

To this union were born six children, all of whom survive. Her mother, father and one brother also preceded her in death.

Mrs. Nelson was taken ill Sunday March 8th, and passed away at Sioux Valley Hospital, March 25th, 1931 at the age of 47 years, 10 months and 29 days.
