Andi C. Andison Rites Held Wednesday, Feb. 16

Funeral services for Andi C. Andison, 92, who died on Monday, Feb. 14th, were held on Wednesday, Feb. 16th, at 1:00 P. M. at the funeral parlors in Viborg, and at 1:30 P. M. from the Spring Valley Lutheran Church. Pallbearers were Chris Lonning, Chris Larsen, Charlie Jensen, Alfred Christensen, Vernie Hansen and Leonard Sorensen. "Rock of Ages" was sung at the funeral parlors, and songs rendered at the church were "I'm A Pilgrim" and "What A Friend We Have In Jesus" by the ladies chorus, and "I Live And I Know The Span Of My Years" by Mrs. Bennie Jensen. Burial was in the church yard cemetery. Rev. H. S. Madsen officiated.

Andi Christian Andison, oldest son of Mr. and Mrs. Anders Andison, was born April 18th, 1862, and died February 14th, 1955, at the age of 92 years, 9 months and 27 days. He was born in Hals Wensysel, Denmark, where he was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. On April 15, 1884, he was united in marriage to Nelsine Nelson and on April 21st of the same year they immigrated to America and settled on a farm 10 miles south of Freeman. Later on, they homesteaded in Buffalo County. In 1907 he purchased a farm southeast of Freeman where he lived until he passed away.

He leaves to mourn his passing, seven children, namely, Minnie, Andrew, Peter of Freeman, Anton of Yankton, John of Hot Springs, Theodore, Myrtle, Mrs. Tony Anderson of Freeman, three grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and one brother, Fred of Sioux Falls, S. D., and other relatives and friends. Preceding him in death were his wife, his parents and two brothers.
