LUDVIG J. ANDERSEN

A host of friends and relatives attended the funeral services for Ludvig J. Andersen, who died suddenly of a heart attack at his home on November 21st. Last rites were held at Our Savior's Lutheran Church last Saturday afternoon. Rev. Harald Ibsen conducted the services and the Viborg Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements. Maurice Rundell sang two solos, "Abide With Me" and "Have Thine Own Way Lord". Pallbearers were: Niels Jespersen, Arthur Nelson, Niels Hansen, Soren Simonsen, Jens Nielsen and John Buck. Interment was at Rose Hill Cemetery.

Ludvig Jorgen Andersen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Christian Jensen, was born Sept. 25, 1886, at Sindal, Denmark. He died Nov. 21st, 1951, at the age of 65 years.

In 1906 he came to America and settled near Hurley. He was united in marriage to Agnes Marie Jensen in 1911. To this union nine children were born.

As a youth, he was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He was an active member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg. He was a member of the D. B. S. Lodge. He was occupied in farming until his retirement in March, 1951, when he moved to Viborg.

He was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Astrid, and his father, Christian Jensen.
